



FSC Coaching Expectations

Findlay Soccer Club expects all coaches to:

1. Comply with all procedures and rules of Findlay Soccer Club.
2. Comply with procedures and rules of the League and Ohio Youth Soccer Association North.
3. Plan and manage effective age appropriate practice sessions that challenge the players to improve their technical and tactical skills.
4. Achieve an age appropriate coaching license within 2 years of becoming a head coach (not required for assistant coaches).
5. Arrive on time for all practices and games. A coach should arrive 15 minutes prior to practice and 30 minutes prior to games.
6. Coach the team in the spirit of the Club's philosophy statement and mission.
7. Be professional on the sideline and be easily identifiable as the coach. Set a positive example for players and parents to follow by demonstrating good sportsmanship to the opponent and respect for game officials.
8. Effectively communicate with the players and parents regarding team expectations, team rules, and practice/game schedules.
9. Attend Findlay Soccer Club's coaches/manager's meetings.
10. Adhere to all policies regarding the use of practice and game fields.
11. Help build the Findlay Soccer Club program through legal recruitment of players and coaches.
12. Place restrictions on players for their benefit and the good of soccer instead of running up the score against weaker opponents.
13. Encourage parent volunteerism during Findlay Soccer Club events.
